ANN KLEIN ADVOCATE AWARDS

The awards are named in memory of Ann Klein, former Commissioner of the NJ Department of Human Services, whose career paved the way for significant advances in the human services systems throughout the State of New Jersey. The awards are given to a group of select individuals and organizations, nominated by the public, who have performed exemplary work as advocates for people living with disabilities and/or vulnerable populations.

MIKE LIONE ACCESSIBILITY AWARD

The award is named in memory of Mike Lione, long-time member of CHLP's Board of Trustees. An executive with New Jersey Bell and Verizon, Mike was a leader in advocacy for Verizon employees with disabilities. Mike was a strong advocate of the Americans with Disabilities Act. The award is presented to an individual or entity that has performed exemplary work as an advocate for accessibility on behalf of persons living with disabilities.
